"With sun setting and the greenery taking new shades every moment, the journey towards Gorumara is a delight for nature lovers and shutterbugs," said a tourist. "Gorumara froset is very well organised and tourists enjoy the accommodation offered in this wilderness."

At Lataguri Nature Interpretation Centre counter, tourists can get a safari jeep and a nature guide to travel with them inside the forest. As the open jeep crawth inside Gorumara, the guide explains to the tourists what to expect and how to be in the wild. The bumps muddy road and the jerks that follow do not rob the tourists or the excitement awaiting inside the national park.
